PRINCIPLES OF HEAD AND NECK ONCOLOGY FOR THE OMS

The Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery Foundation (OMS Foundation) has designated funds to provide scholarship assistance to Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery Residents and Fellows interested in learning more about the current surgical and scientific developments in head and neck oncology with preference for resident applications. These scholarship awards support attendance at the AAOMS Principles of Head and Neck Oncology for the OMS taking place in Rosemont, IL from March 7- 8th, 2020. The OMS Foundation will grant a maximum of five (5) individual scholarships.

Each recipient will be reimbursed (up to \$1,000) for lodging and travel costs directly associated with the course. Scholarship funds will be disbursed upon receipt of a written summary of the awardee's experience and detailed expenses (with original receipts). The scholarship recipients will be selected mid-February and notification letters to the applicants will be mailed shortly after. Recipient names may appear in AAOMS and OMS Foundation print and electronic communications.

THE SCHOLARSHIP CANDIDATE MUST

1. Be a current member of ROAAOMS or AAOMS.
2. Provide a written statement summarizing qualifications for receiving the scholarship and what he/she hopes to obtain by attending the AAOMS Principles of Head and Neck Oncology for the OMS Conference, including interests in research.
3. Provide a current CV.
4. Provide any supporting documentation he/she feels is important in evaluating the application.
5. Submit the completed scholarship application to the OMS Foundation.

The OMS Foundation must receive the completed application by January 15, 2020 at 11:59 PM CDT.

CONDITIONS OF AWARD

1. Scholarship is used to attend the AAOMS Principles of Head and Neck Oncology for the OMS
2. Scholarship funds are for two nights of hotel and course-related travel costs for awardee.
3. The recipient is responsible for the balance of transportation and per diem expenses.
4. The recipient must submit a written summary of his/her experience at the Clinical Trials Methods Course within 30 days following the event. The application documents and written summary will become the property of the OMS Foundation.
