OMS FOUNDATION RESIDENT SCHOLARSHIP

CLINICAL TRIALS METHODS COURSE

APPLICATIONS ARE DUE APRIL 1, 2022

The Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery Foundation (OMS Foundation) has designated funds to provide scholarship assistance to Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery Residents interested in research. These scholarship awards support attendance at the AAOMS Clinical Trials Methods Course taking place in Rosemont, IL from May 4 – 6, 2022. The OMS Foundation will grant a maximum of fifteen (15) individual scholarships.

Each recipient will be reimbursed (up to \$1,000) for registration, lodging and travel costs directly associated with the course. Scholarship funds will be disbursed upon receipt of a written summary of the awardee's experience and detailed expenses (with original receipts). Scholarship recipients will be selected at the beginning of April and notification letters to the applicants will be emailed by April 15. Recipient names may appear in AAOMS and OMS Foundation print and electronic communications.

THE SCHOLARSHIP CANDIDATE MUST

1. Be a current member of ROAAOMS.
2. Provide a written statement summarizing qualifications for receiving the scholarship and what he/she hopes to obtain by attending the 2022 Clinical Trials Methods Course, including interests in research.
3. Provide a current CV.
4. Provide any supporting documentation he/she feels is important in evaluating the application.
5. Submit the completed scholarship application to the OMS Foundation as a single PDF document.
6. Not accept monetary support from other sources.

The OMS Foundation must receive the completed application by April 1, 2022 at 11:59 PM CDT.

CONDITIONS OF AWARD

1. Scholarship is used to attend the 2022 Clinical Trials Methods Course.
2. Scholarship funds are for two nights of hotel and course-related travel costs for awardee, up to \$1,000.
3. The recipient is responsible for the balance of transportation and per diem expenses.
4. The recipient must submit a written summary of his/her experience at the Clinical Trials Methods Course within 30 days following the event. The application documents and written summary will become the property of the OMS Foundation.
